6. **Temporary Road Closure – Club Targa Inc. Silver Fern Rally**

The matter for consideration by the Council is a temporary road closure application from Club Targa Inc. to enable five stages of the Silver Fern Rally to take place on roads within the New Plymouth district.

- a. The Council remediates, immediately thereafter, any damage that results from this or any similar event, in order that local communities are not disadvantaged by special interests that damage rural roads. It should also be noted that Kiwi Road is currently closed due to a major slip.
- b. On the proviso the above is undertaken, the following road closures be approved:

Event: Club Targa Inc. - Silver Fern Rally

Stage 13 Waitaanga Road: from 2.40pm to 7.10pm on Sunday 25 November.

Road to be closed:

- Road closures commence in the Ruapehu district.
- Waitaanga Road from the boundary with Ruapehu district to 300m before the intersection with Okau Road.

Stage 14 Kiwi Road: from 3.25pm to 7.55pm on Sunday 25 November.

Road to be closed:

- Kiwi Road from 300m south of the intersection with Okau and Moki roads.

- Moki Road from Kiwi Road to 1300m before the intersection with Uruti Road.

Affected side roads, with no access out due to adjoining road closure:

- Makarakia, Rerekino and Makino North roads, Moki Road from Kiwi Road to Rerekino Road, Moki Track.

Stage 15 Kaka Road: from 4pm to 8.30pm on Sunday 25 November.

Road to be closed:

- Kaka Road from 300m west of the intersection with Uruti Road to 300m before the intersection with Okoki Road.

Stage 18 Mangapapa Road: from 9.50am to 2.20pm on Monday 26 November.

Road to be closed:

- Road closures commence in the Stratford District.
- Okau Road from the boundary with Stratford District to 300m before the intersection with Waitaanga Road.
- Further road closures in the Ruapehu district.

Stage 19 Tongaporutu-Ohura Road: from 10.15am to 2.45pm on Monday 26 November.

Road to be closed:

- Waitaanga Road from 300m north of the intersection with Okau Road to the boundary with Ruapehu district.
- Road closures continue in the Ruapehu district.

The above road closure is subject to the conditions outlined in correspondence to Club Targa Inc. dated 25 July 2018. Refer Appendix 1.
