**Freedom Camping Bylaw**

The Inglewood Community Board has elected not to make a submission, instead we support in principle the submission of the Kaitake Community Board and in particular, the comments about the Coastal Reserves Management Plan prohibiting camping.

The consensus we arrived at is that while we don't have much freedom camping activity in our board area, we think that to have a Bylaw contradict the Coastal Reserves Management Plan is flawed and if the Coastal Reserves Management Plan was policed there may not be a freedom camping issue.

Generally, the thought was that non-certified self-contained freedom camping should not be allowed, full stop. This is also supported in the General Policies for Council Administered Reserves
