



**Win a Method waste station Competition Prize Draw  
Terms and Conditions**

- 1 New Plymouth District Council (the **Council**) wishes to encourage local businesses operating in the New Plymouth District to reduce and manage waste. Each business who completes the Council's Business Waste Survey with their contact details will be automatically entered into the prize draw to win a set of three [Method](#) recycling bins of their choice, valued at \$595 (**Prize**).
- 2 Eligibility for the prize draw will close at 5.00pm on Friday 5 July 2019 (**Closing Date**).
- 3 Employees and elected members of the Council and their immediate families are ineligible to win the Prize.
- 4 To be eligible for the Prize:
  - a. the survey submitter must work for or be an owner of a business or organisation operating from a physical premises in the New Plymouth District; and
  - b. the completed survey must be received by the Council by the Closing Date, with contact details provided.
- 5 The prize draw will be conducted by random selection at the Council Civic Centre, Liardet Street, New Plymouth after the Closing Date. If the selected submitter is ineligible under these terms and conditions, the Council will re-draw the Prize until an eligible name has been drawn.
- 6 The winner will be notified by email or phone by Friday 19 July 2019.
- 7 The Council reserves the right to terminate, modify or cancel the prize draw or withdraw or substitute the Prize at any time without notice.
- 8 The Prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
- 9 The winner agrees that their name and photo may be used for promotional, media and publicity purposes (including social media and website pages of the Council).
- 10 When collecting personal information, the Council complies with the Privacy Act 1993 and the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.
- 11 The winner must agree to these terms and conditions as a condition of accepting the Prize, and the business owner must also agree to these terms and conditions and be willing to accept the Prize.
