5A COUNCIL ROAD NAMING REPORT

Final list of proposed road names

When selecting proposed names for the final list in the Council Road Naming Report, the following criteria will apply:

- a) **Where more than four names are considered appropriate:**
In the event more than four merit inclusion on the final list, Council officers will table all names for the Committee's consideration;
- b) **Where a total of four names are received:**
If the total number of proposals received numbers four, all names will be tabled before the Committee for their consideration;
- c) **Where a total of three or less names are received:**
If a total of three or less names are received, alternative names may be proposed by Council officers. In such cases, affected parties will be:
 - Notified of the new proposed name(s);
 - Provided an explanation for why the name(s) have been proposed; and
 - Offered the opportunity to provide feedback; and
- d) Where possible, at least one name with a Māori association must be included in any final list of proposed road names.
