

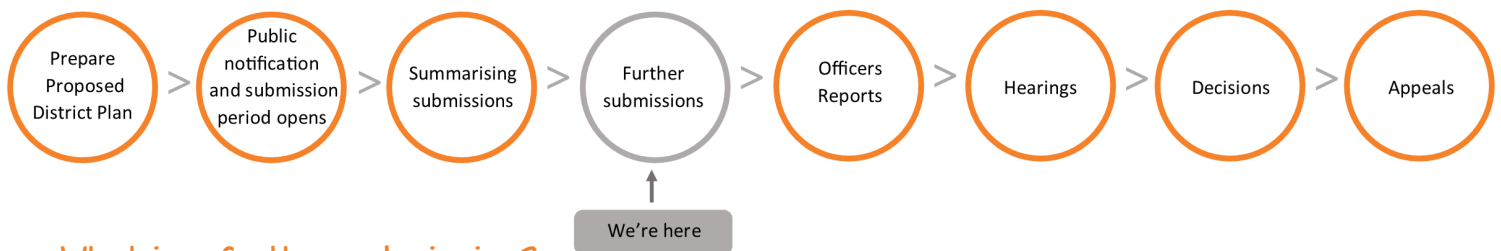
Proposed District Plan: Further Submissions



Notification of summary of submissions reports

Thank you to everyone who made a submission on the Proposed District Plan. We have worked through all the submissions and created a summary of the decisions requested by submitters. The summary of submissions reports can be viewed from Wednesday 12th August 2020, on Council's Proposed District Plan page (www.newplymouthnz.com/eplan).

The next step in the process is the call for further submissions on the Proposed District Plan. Further submissions must be made by [5pm Tuesday 25 August 2020](#).



What is a further submission?

The further submission period is an opportunity for affected parties, people with certain interests or local authorities to comment in support or opposition of the submissions received.

You can make a further submission if you are a:

1. Person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest.
2. Person with an interest in the proposed plan that is deemed greater than the interest of the general public.
3. The local authority.

For example, public interest environmental groups

For example, if someone submitted to rezone a block of land that includes your property, you have the opportunity to make comment on that submission.



? I didn't make a submission on the Proposed Plan. Can I make my first submission during the further submission period?

Yes you can, if you meet the above criteria

Please note that this is not a call for new submission points and topics. A further submission can only be made on an original submission or submission point.



If you made a submission following notification of the Proposed Plan in 2019, you **do not** have to make a further submission. Your original submission will stand. However if someone has made a submission that impacts on you, then you have an opportunity to comment. See the following page for tips on making a further submission.

How long do I have to make a further submission?

The further submission period is open for 10 working days from when the summary of submissions reports were notified on Wednesday 12 August 2020.

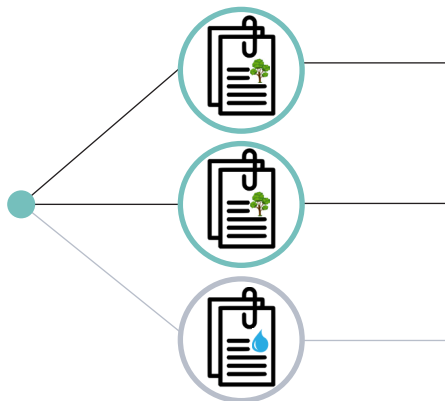

Checklist before making a further submission:



Support

Keep in scope

You can:

Support their submission point(s)

Oppose their submission point(s)

Make sure your issue is the same as the issues raised in this submission. A further submission can only address submission points.

i.e. It cannot introduce new matters.

Where can I find the submissions, summaries and further submission form?

Head over to the [Proposed District Plan page on Council's website \(www.newplymouthnz.com/eplan\)](http://www.newplymouthnz.com/eplan) to:

- Check out copies of all original submissions recieved on the Proposed Plan;
- View the summary of submissions reports;
- Find a copy of the further submission form or fill it out online.

Here are some key things to remember about the further submission process

1. The further submission period is short and only open for 10 working days.
2. You do not have to make a further submission, as your original submission will still be considered.
3. Further submissions need to be on matters raised within the original submissions and cannot introduce new issues.
4. You need to clearly identify the parts of the submission you are concerned with. This includes stating:
 - whether you oppose or support the submission point,
 - the reasons for your support or opposition, and
 - the decision you would like NPDC to make in relation to the submission.

Important!

5. You must send a copy of your further submission to the person who made the original submission within five working days of lodging it with Council. A list of submitter details are located on the Proposed District Plan page on Council's website, along with the summary of submissions reports.



Remember, we must receive your further submission by:

5pm TUES 25 AUG 2020
