

## 8. Terms and conditions for a no-spray zone

- 8a. The applicant, by applying for a no-spray zone, agrees to
- i. Maintain the no-spray zone in a tidy condition free of excess vegetation including roadside planting.
  - ii. Not permit vegetation height to exceed 150mm above the berm around roadside signs, marker pegs, the road edge and drainage channel inverts in a rural area.
  - iii. Keep the no-spray zone free of all pest plants.
  - iv. Ensure that stormwater flow is not impeded by keeping stormwater drainage ditches clear of pest plants and excess vegetation.
  - v. Ensure footpaths are kept clear and there is no overhanging vegetation.
  - v. The agreement being cancelled if the applicant does not comply with the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- 8b. The applicant acknowledges that
- i. The no-spray zone is from the road centreline to the boundary of the applicant's property and the agreed length of property frontage.
  - ii. The Council will endeavour to ensure that the no-spray zone is excluded from its chemical spraying programme but provides no guarantee to this effect.
  - iii. The Council and/or its spraying contractor will not be responsible for any damage caused from accidental spraying.
  - iv. In the event of the no-spray zone failing to comply with this agreement, the Council reserves the right to revoke the no-spray status without notice and instruct the spraying contractor to include the area in all future chemical spraying programmes.
  - v. No-spray zones are reviewed annually. An application form and letter will be sent to the postal address showing on the no-spray zone record. If the Council does not receive a response, the no-spray zone will be removed from the list.

## 9. Privacy statement

The Privacy Act 1993 applies to the personal information provided in this application. For the purposes of implementing this application the Council may disclose that personal information to another party. The applicant is entitled to have access to, and request correction of, that personal information.
