

APPENDIX EIGHT – SUBMITTERS SUGGESTIONS ON FURTHER SCV FREEDOM CAMPING SITE RESTRICTIONS

Areas where Council will consider site specific restrictions to SCV freedom camping should ongoing issues arise – would require an amendment to the FC Bylaw

- Waitara East Beach
- Marine Park, Waitara
- Bell Block Beach – restricted / prohibited
- Fitzroy Golf Course main carpark: prohibited
- Fitzroy Golf Course – behind the club rooms: restricted
- Carpark opposite Workingmens Club
- Wind Wand carpark
- Greenwood Road
- Lower Kaihihi Road
- Freedom camping should not be permitted at beaches, reserves, parks – these are public spaces and the facilities are for rate payers and visitors to enjoy, but not to be used as camping areas. They are easily overwhelmed by campers, making them less enjoyable to visit
- Information centre carpark
- Pukekura Park
- Brooklands Park
- TSB Stadium
- Anywhere the local people use that is popular already
- Areas could have restrictions for peak times only (e.g. summer months) – this suggestion has been incorporated into specific site recommendations.
- Areas sensitive to iwi – note: iwi were notified of the proposed Freedom Camping Bylaw and invited to provide information on sites which freedom camping should be prohibited / restricted from

Areas not considered reasonable under the FCA for Council to consider site specific restrictions to SCV freedom camping

- All residential areas
- All urban areas of the district
- The CBD area
- There is no public place that is suitable for freedom camping, if private residents want to make their back yards or homes available, then they should be allowed.

Areas not under Council jurisdiction under the FCA

- Coastal surf breaks (e.g. Paora Road) – note Paora Road is not in NPDC boundary)
- National parks – note, national parks are not Council controlled or managed land
